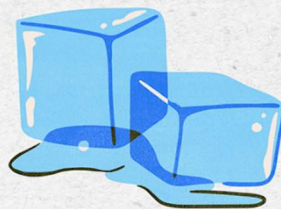
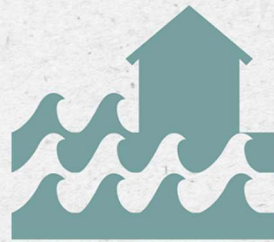


WATER SCARCITY IN ARID REGIONS

INTERNATIONAL WATER EFFORTS

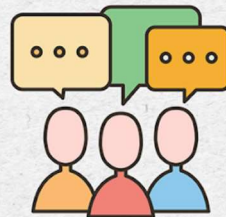


UNITED NATIONS SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS
